I read your letter dated June 18, 2007. In the letter you alleged that Detective McClain acted inappropriately while booking you into Yavapai County Jail on February 2, 2007.


Detective McClain arrested you on a valid felony warrant. He took you to the jail and while completing your paperwork, a member of the jail staff looked over his shoulder and saw the charge on your warrant. This charge was not familiar to the Detention Officer, so he asked Detective McClain what it was all about. He told the Detention Officer to look up your name on the Internet and he could learn out about you. This is a common practice in Law Enforcement in order to share information. He did not tell them where to look or what to look at on the Internet. He completed the booking and left the jail. He did not supply any documents to the jail staff from the Internet, as stated in your wife's correspondence, which accompanied your letter. He did not pass out any pamphlets about you, nor did he point out anything specific on the Internet. Detective McClain simply told them they could find out about you on the Internet. This was a true and accurate statement.

Detective McClain was given information that you lived in Prescott and had a felony warrant. He located you and arrested you. This is no different than the hundreds of arrests we make every year and continue to make on a daily basis. Detective McClain has made many arrests before you and many since you. He has placed no special importance on the arrest of you. I, as his supervisor, have found nothing inordinate about this arrest.

There will be no further investigation into this accusation.
