DECLARATION OF TOM KLEMESRUD

I, Tom Klemesrud, declare:

- 1. The facts set forth in this declaration are known to me personally. If called to testify as to the truthfulness of the facts set forth in this declaration, I would do so.
- 2. The evening of January 14, 1995 I was subjected to a bizarre incident where a woman I had met at a bar spread blood in the bathroom and bedroom of my apartment
- 3. This incident was reported in as much detail as was known at the time in the Skeptic vol. 3, no. 3, 1995, pp. 35-41 (attached as Exhibit A). April 30, 2002 Keith Henson retold the story with details that had come out in the intervening years in Exhibit B (South of the Border at the Road Kill Café). Where I am mentioned the stories are accurate. Henson made the case in his article that I had probably been drugged with a Schedule 4 drug, chloral hydrate, something I could not confirm at that time.
- 4. Last October I underwent a medical test in which chloral hydrate was administered in a failed attempt to induce sleep. I found that this drug has a specific hangover effect, and a certain lingering after taste to it.
- I recognized the effect and after taste as identical to that I had experienced January
 14, 1995 and the next day.
- I am now convinced that I was surreptitiously dosed with chloral hydrate (the classic "Mickey Finn") the evening of January 14, 1995.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of United States and Texas that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. Signed in Mission, Texas.
